## What is...?

### Preschool Promise

Preschool Promise is a high-quality, publicly funded program delivered in a variety of settings including centers, homes, and schools.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 3-4 years old on/by September 1, 2022
- 0-200% FPL

### Oregon Prekindergarten (OPK)

OPK is a comprehensive preschool program.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 3-4 years old
- 0-130% FPL

### Head Start

Head Start program supports children's growth and development in a positive learning environment through a variety of services, which include quality Early Childhood Education, Health, Nutrition and Social Services.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 3-5 years old
- 0-130% FPL

### Migrant, Seasonal Head Start

9-month program for those who work in agriculture (51% of income must come from agriculture) including nurseries, dairy, canneries, livestock, poultry, fish, bees.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 6 weeks–5 years old
- 0-130% FPL
- April–November/extended summer hours

### Migrant Head Start

10-week preschool program from June–August.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 6 weeks–5 years old
- 0-130% FPL

## What is...?

### Early Head Start

Early Head Start supports children's growth and development in a positive learning environment through a variety of services, which include quality Early Childhood Education, Health, Nutrition and Social Services.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 0–3 years old
- 0–130% FPL
- Serves expectant mothers of all ages
- Serves children with disabilities, foster children, homeless children/families

### Migrant, Seasonal Head Start

Migrant and Seasonal Head Start and Early Head Start provides child development services to economically disadvantaged children and families. Migrant and Seasonal Head Start are for children of migrant and seasonal farm workers.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 6 weeks–3 years old
- 0-130% FPL
- Eligible for those who work in Agriculture (51% of income must come from agriculture) including nurseries, dairy, canneries, livestock, poultry, fish, bees

### Oregon Pre-kindergarten Prenatal-3 (OPK P-3)

OPK P–3 emphasizes the role of parents as their child's first and most important teacher and builds relationships with families to support. Prenatal to three years old.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 6 weeks–3 years old
- 0-130% FPL
- Serves expectant mothers

### Early Head Start Child Care Partnerships

Child care providers work with our team of specialists and experts to elevate the quality of their child care to meet Early Head Start standards. These programs are year-round and offer full day services.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- 0–3 years old who are eligible for Early Head Start
- Families must be low-income or have a child with an identified disability
- Families receiving child care subsidies
- Homeless families, foster families, and working families
